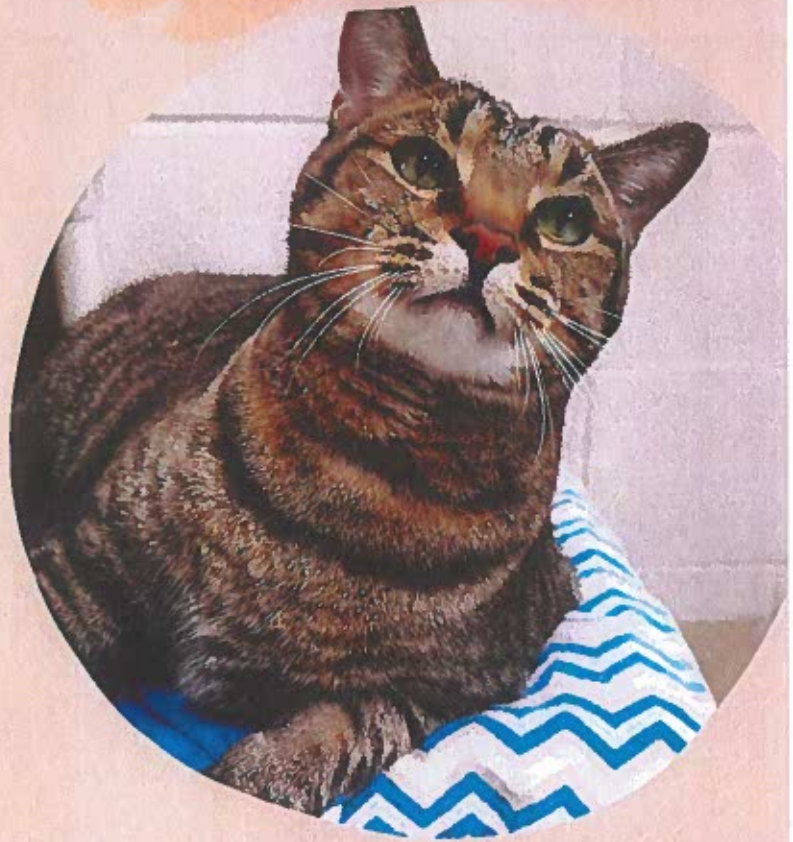

## 2022 Year in Review

2022 the Humane Society saw the completion of many much-needed renovations! Electrical, lighting, HVAC, painting, insulation, door repairs, concrete replacement, new skylight panels in the kennel, and even an expansion of a visiting room were completed.



We continued to care for homeless pets of Hancock County during the renovations – pets like Star (pictured). Star lived at the Humane Society for upwards of 6 months. When Star first arrived, she was full of life – happy and outgoing! Unfortunately living in the Shelter for that long started to change Star. She was becoming depressed, and not enjoying the things which normally made her happy.

Luckily Ryan, a kind soul, offered to foster Star until the perfect family came around. Star thrived under her new foster dad, and he ended up adopting her. The Humane Society and homeless pets wouldn't be able to function without the generous community – thank you!

The spay & neuter clinic continued to see many patients from Hancock County and surrounding areas; demonstrating the continued need for access to high-quality, low-cost spay/neuter services in the area. We were able to spay and neuter **1,013 public** dogs/cats in 2022; that figure does not include the dogs/cats that were altered for our adoption program.

The Maxwell Meyers Memorial Golf Classic & Mutt Strut was a success in 2022! Let your golf buddies know the 2023 Golf Classic will be held on May 12, 2022, at Sycamore Springs with a new time; 1:00 pm.

It is our goal to continue to be an integral part of our community and continue to gain the support needed to serve the animals that are in our care. We cannot do it alone, as we saw with Star, we need help from the community too. Thank you all for making it possible to care for the homeless pets of Hancock County!

### **Director's Report**

Paula Krugh welcomed and thanked everyone for attending the Annual Meeting. She stated the Humane Society facility is currently under construction. The two smaller getting acquainted rooms on the east side of the building are currently being transformed into one larger room. The new flooring for that room is almost complete. Countertops for the surgery room will be installed the week of March 21, 2022.

The low cost spay/neuter clinic at the Humane Society is almost up by 200 public surgeries from last year.

We received two grants; one from the Community Foundation & one from the City of Findlay. Both grants are to combat the over population of cats in our community.

The Humane Society's Golf Outing in memory of Maxwell Meyers is scheduled for May 13, 2022 at Sycamore Springs. Please try your best to raise awareness for this event, as it's our only major event for the year.
